FOR DOORS WITH HAND CRANK SYSTEMS

The emergency manual operation is provided as a means to open or close the door when power is not available. Manual operation interrupts the control voltage and so electrical operation is no longer possible.

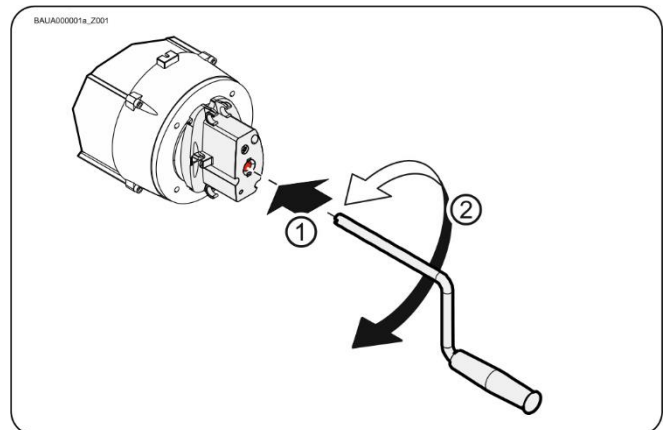

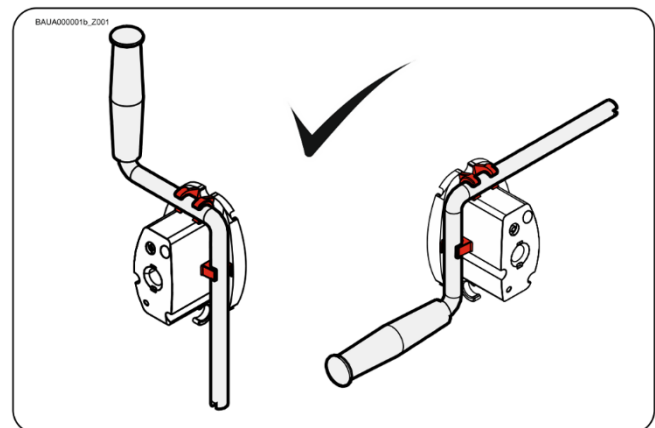
- Disconnect the power supply

Insert the crank and turn until it latches (1)

Turn the crank to open or close (2)



The crank can be mounted to the drive unit after usage
